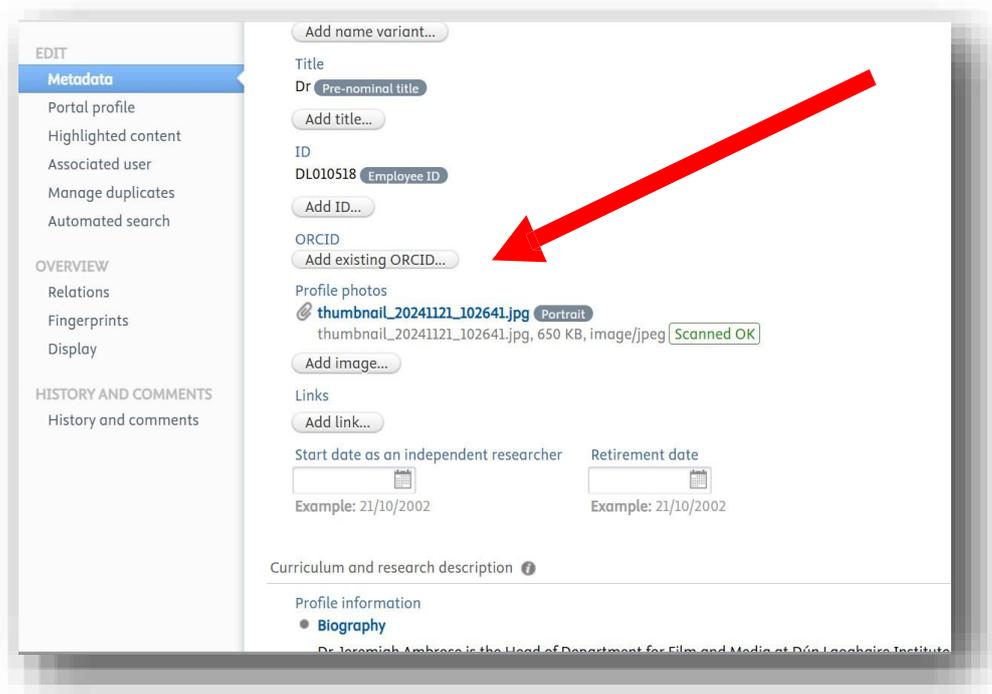
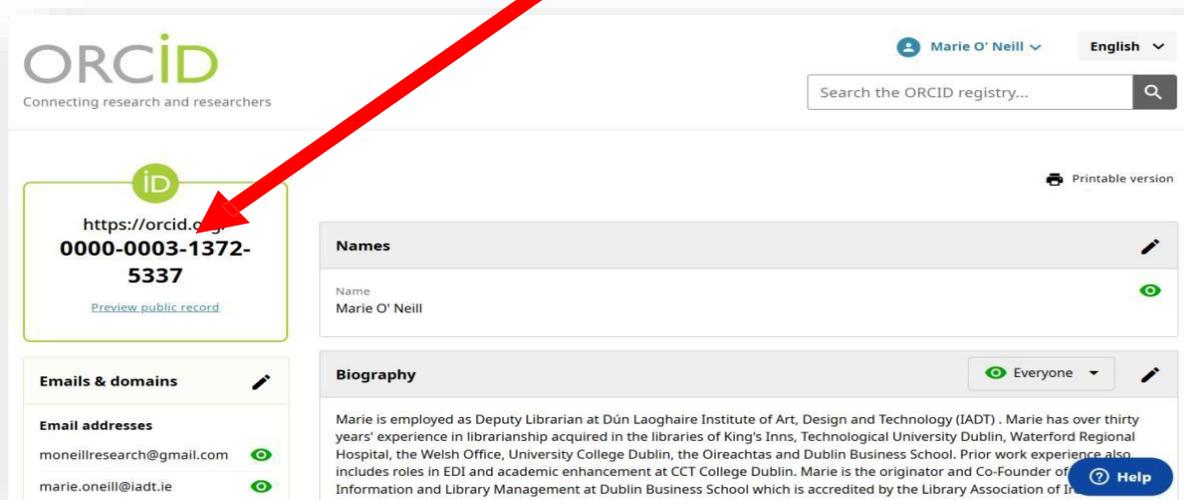


Importing from ORCID to Pure

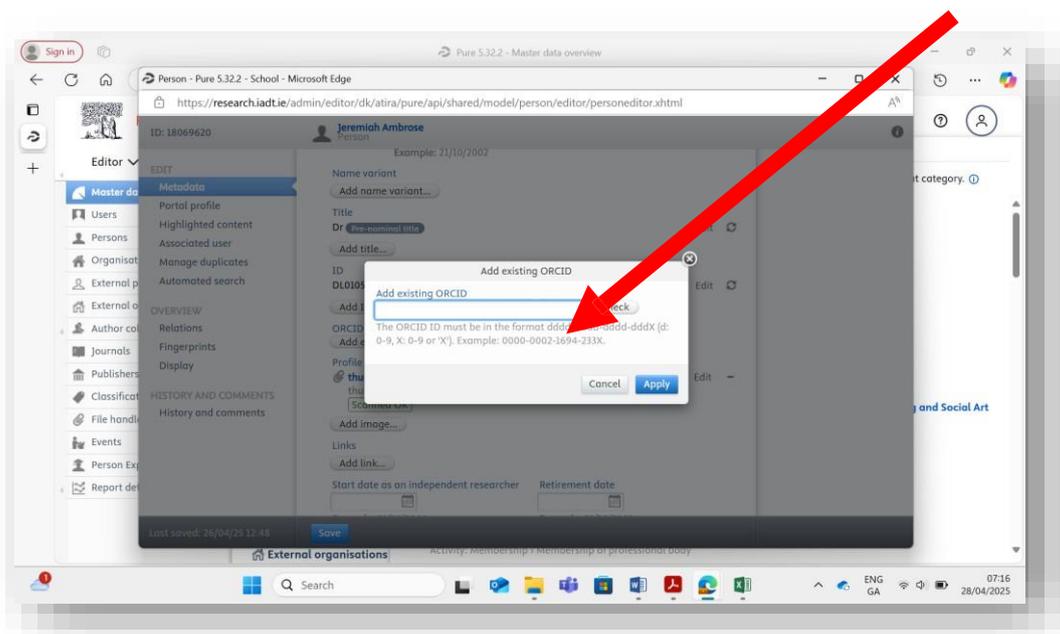
Go to <https://research.iadt.ie/admin/> and log in using your usual IADT credentials (the same username and password you use for your IADT email and other IADT services)
After logging in, select **"Edit Profile"** to access your profile settings.



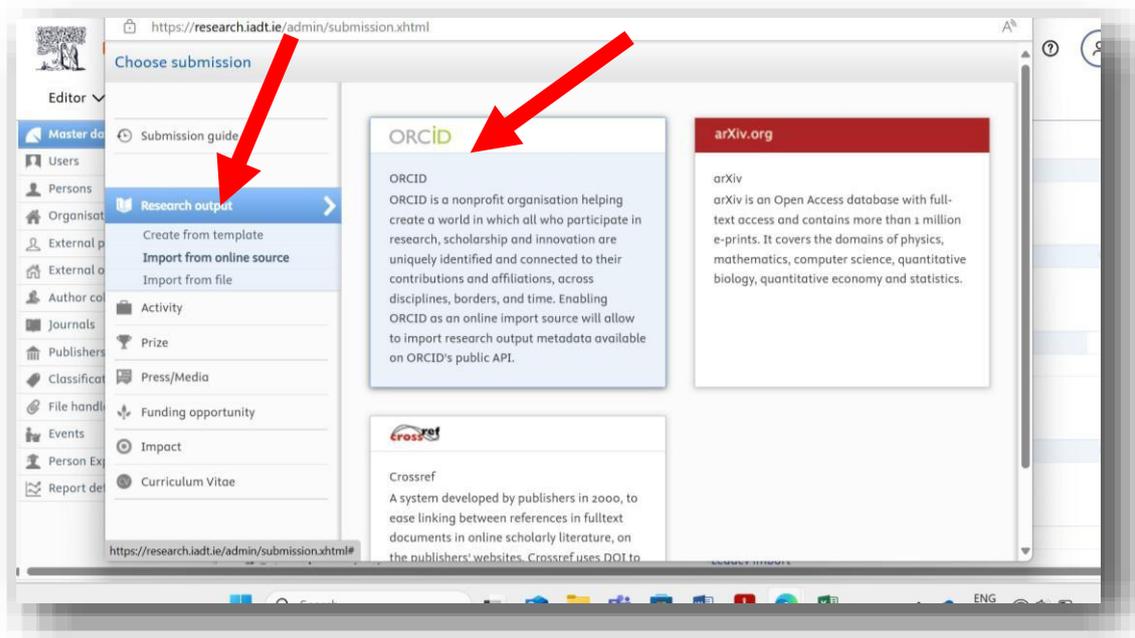
Your ORCID ID number can be found in the top left corner of your ORCID profile page.



When prompted by Pure, enter your ORCID ID. Then, follow the on-screen instructions to link and synchronise your Pure account with your ORCID profile.

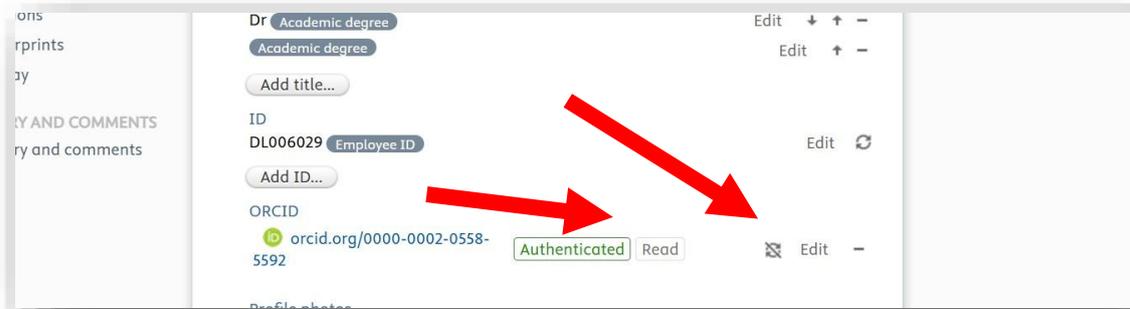


Once your Pure account is connected to ORCID, you can add content in Pure by selecting "Import from Online Source" and then choosing "ORCID" under Research Output. This will display a list of your scholarly activities from ORCID. You can then manually choose to import or reject each item as needed.

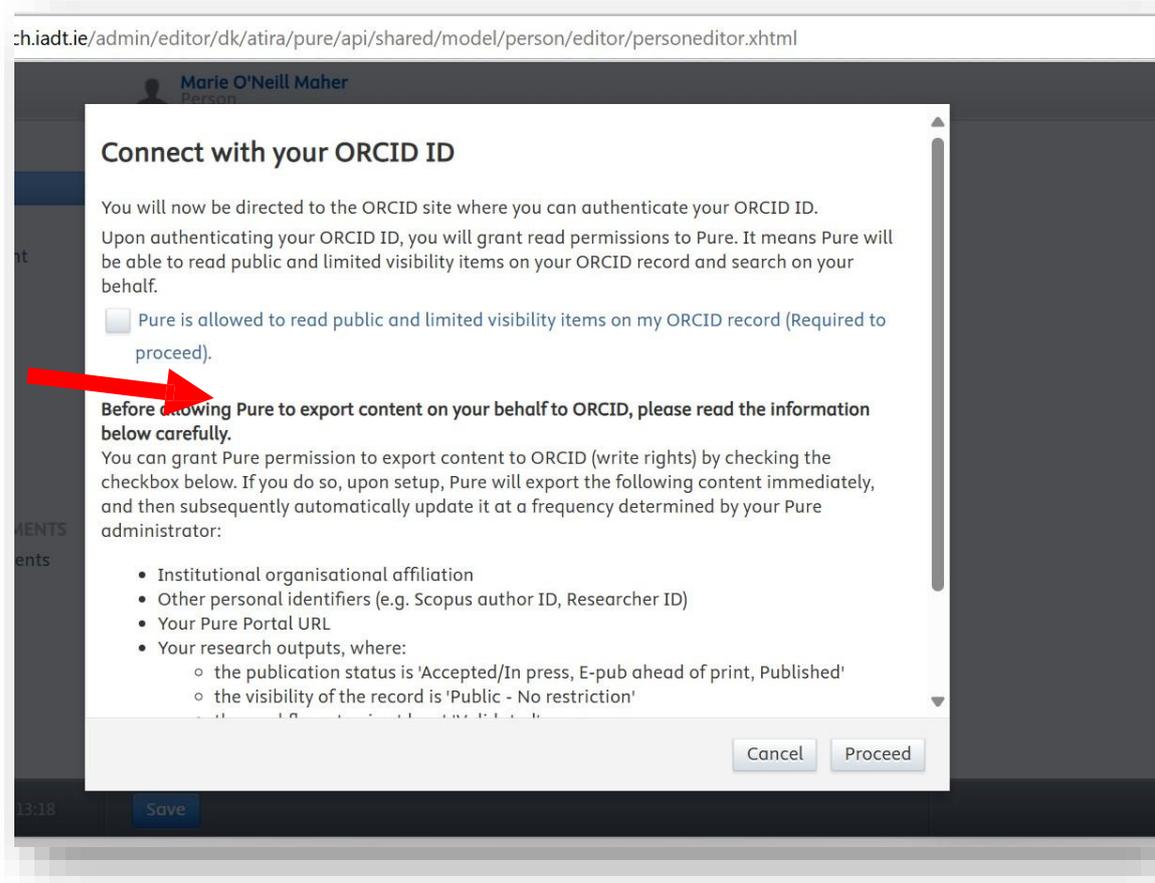


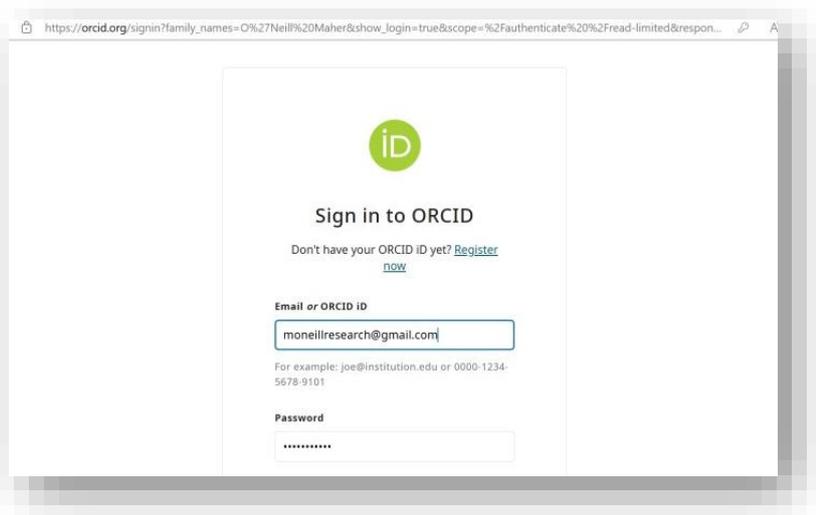
Exporting from Pure to ORCID

To enable the export to ORCID feature, go to Edit Profile and reauthenticate your ORCID account. This is the fastest way to activate the connection. At this stage, ORCID will appear in your Edit Profile section with a "read" status. (See screenshot below for reference.)

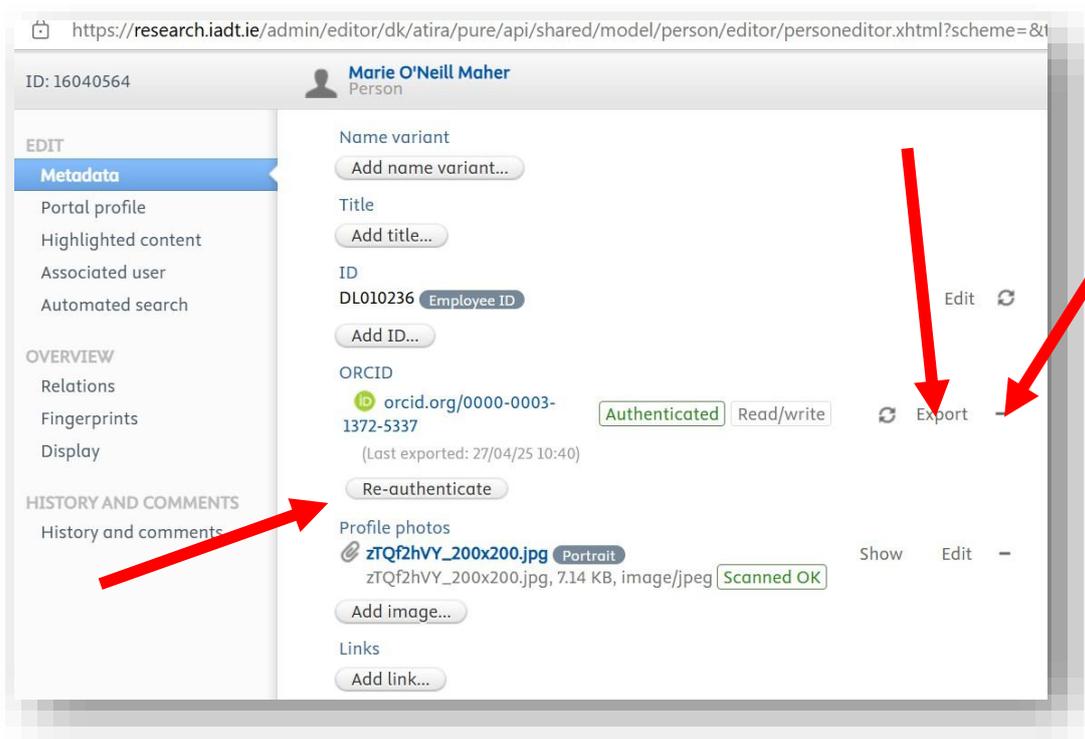


The following message appears providing information about the export and import features related to connecting with ORCID. Please authorise both features and continue.

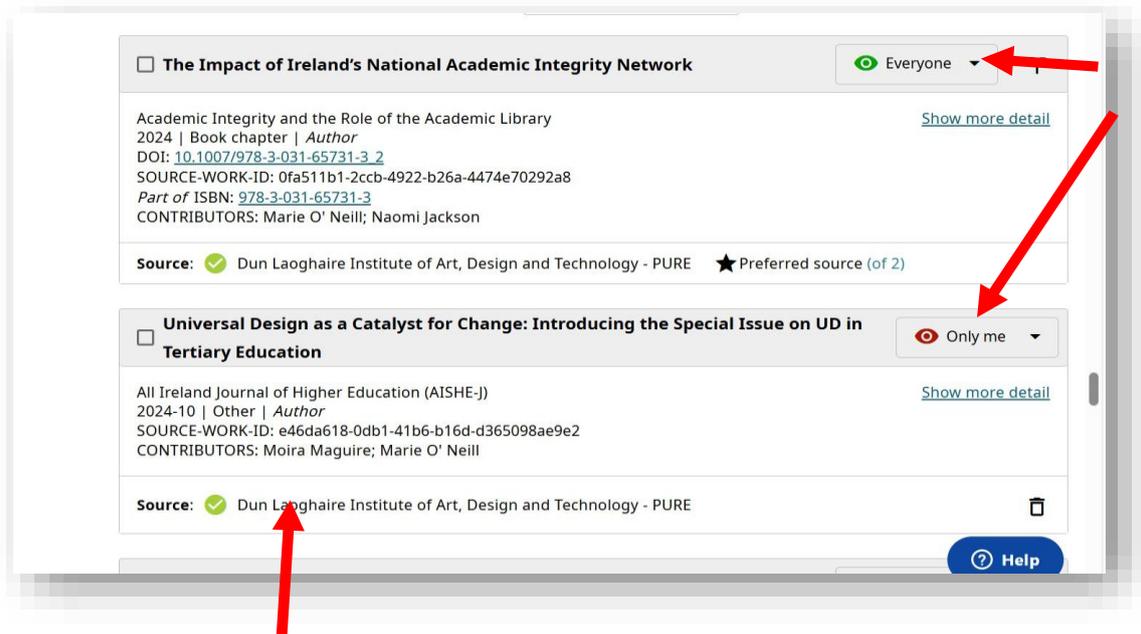




You will then be returned to the Edit Profile section of your Pure profile. Notice that "read and write" now appears next to the ORCID ID section. Click the circle, then press "Save." The word "Export" will appear. Click "Export" to transfer your content to ORCID. Please refer to the screenshots below for guidance.



After completing this step, you will be taken back to the Edit Profile section of your Pure profile. You should now see "read and write" displayed next to the ORCID ID section. Click the circle to select it, then click "Save." Once you do this, the word "Export" will appear. Click "Export" to transfer your content to ORCID.
